Because of Frank's job with the United States Employment Service, the couple lived in Devils Lake, New Rockford, Wahpeton, and San Antonio, TX. Florence worked as a Williams County election judge on many occasions. She was a very involved member of Concordia Lutheran Church in Williston. She taught Sunday school, Vacation Bible school and Confirmation classes at the church for many years and also attended their Bible studies. Florence was a long time Minnesota Twins fan. She was a beloved wife, mother, sister, and friend.

Due to declining health, in April 2009, Florence moved from Williston to live with her son, Jay, and his wife, Joan, in Rochester, MN. She made many friends there and attended Redeemer Lutheran Church. In April 2011 she suffered a severe stroke and was cared for by her son and the staff at the Golden Living Center East in Rochester

She is survived by her son, Jay (Joan) Kurtz of Rochester, MN; grandsons, Rob Freeman and Daiv Freeman; four great-grandchildren; and sister, Faye Tallakson of Edina, MN.
