In 1957, Bob married Joyce Reidle and from this marriage there were two children, Mike and Connie. He owned and operated his own tire business in Fairview. Bob also did custom haying for many years, even still hauling hay for people right up to his death.

As a young boy, Bob served as an altar boy for the Catholic Church. He was on the Fairview Volunteer Fire Department for 20 years and was the Fire Chief for many years. Bob was a member of the Fairview Jaycees for many years. He was twice voted as the outstanding Jaycee of the year for his service raising money for the old Fairview swimming pool. Bob had a love for animals, his horse-Dolly Anne, many cats, dogs and rabbits. He always made sure they were well fed and warm.
