


In the spring of 1979, the family moved to Sidney and for 40 years, Terry worked in the oil field for several different companies. In 1992, he was able to find a place outside of town to get back into his passion of horses. Terry broke and trained colts and after a while he turned to team roping. He and his son, Jamie and families, were members of the Sidney Saddle Club. The next best thing to come for Terry, were his grandchildren, Ben, Abby, Belle, Nathan and Danny who he loved playing with and sharing his knowledge with.

Terry retired in early October of 2018, with plans to continue doing the things he loved and spending time with his grandchildren, who meant so much to him. He will be greatly missed.

Terry passed away on Friday evening, January 4, 2019, while clearing trees on his land in rural Sidney. 
