

Theodor "Butch" Jensen was born on October 30, 1940, in Miles City, MT, to Theodor and Margaret (Glodoski) Jensen. After high school, he joined his sister, Betty and brother-in-law, Russ in Monroe, OR working for BLM until leaving for the Army.

After an honorable discharge from the Army, he returned to Sidney, MT and worked for his parents at Sidney Locker & Creamery as a butcher and meat cutter. In 1965 Butch married Ellen Pederson in Sidney. Into that union four sons were born.
