Edna was born August 20, 1931 to William and Leah (Kaufman) Seader. Edna grew up on a farm three miles north of Sidney, the oldest of five children. The Seader family moved to a farm five miles north of Fairview later moving to the Big Opening. Edna attended schools in Fairview, graduating from Fairview High School in 1949.

Edna was united in marriage to Robert Julius Dahl on June 28, 1950, they made their home in Trenton, ND before moving to Sidney and later Dore, ND. They had six children, Mike, Bill, Debbie, Julie, Gary, and Randy. In 1956, Edna began working at Holly Sugar Factory as an accounting clerk. She retired from Holly Sugar in 1994. Edna was well known for her endless baking, canning, gardening, crafting and ceramics. She was an avid league bowler and later enjoyed cross-country skiing. She cut and dried flowers and delivered flower arrangements to St. John's Lutheran Church in Fairview for Sunday services. She volunteered her time at the Sidney Hospital gift shop. Edna had a green thumb and raised flowers and vegetables in her own backyard greenhouse. In the spring, her kids often came in for supper, only to find her sterilizing dirt for her greenhouse in the oven. Each year, she maintained 100 yards of perennials along the driveway at Dore.

Edna was united in marriage to Gerald Beierle on July 8, 1988 at the International Peace Gardens in North Dakota. Together, they enjoyed traveling and hoped to attend all of their grandchildren's high school graduations.

Edna died at Sidney Health Center on Tuesday, February 24, 2009.
