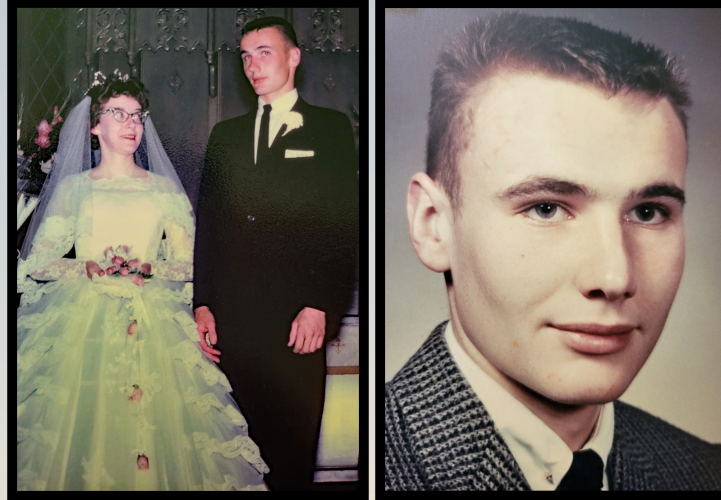
**MARCH 24, 1943 - JULY 15, 2023**
