One of the first things he did each morning was make Mary her tea and a nutrition shake. He kept the freezers well-stocked with curated recipes of deer sausage, jerky, and walleye.

After retiring from the auto body business, he worked at the Tioga City Park. Then he became the maintenance man at the Community Center, where he had a special bond with his coworkers.

He continued working and spending time in his garden after the cancer diagnosis up until a couple months prior to his passing.

He will be missed by so many down here. As a believer in his Savior Jesus, we can rest easy knowing he's at home in Heaven.
