

Bethine "Beth" D. Sperry, 91 of Sidney, MT formerly of Beach, ND passed away peacefully on Tuesday, September 17, 2024, at the Sidney Health Center Extended care, surrounded by her family. She was born in Beach, ND, on July 16, 1933, to Kyle and Lillian (Russell) Sperry. She rode horses with her sisters to CS Divide School through 8th grade and graduated from Beach High School.

Bethine began her professional career working at the ASCS Office in Beach. From there she moved to Kansas City, KS and began working for the Kansas Association of Wheat Growers. She was then recruited to work at the National Association of Wheat Growers in Washington DC and resided in Alexandria, VA.
