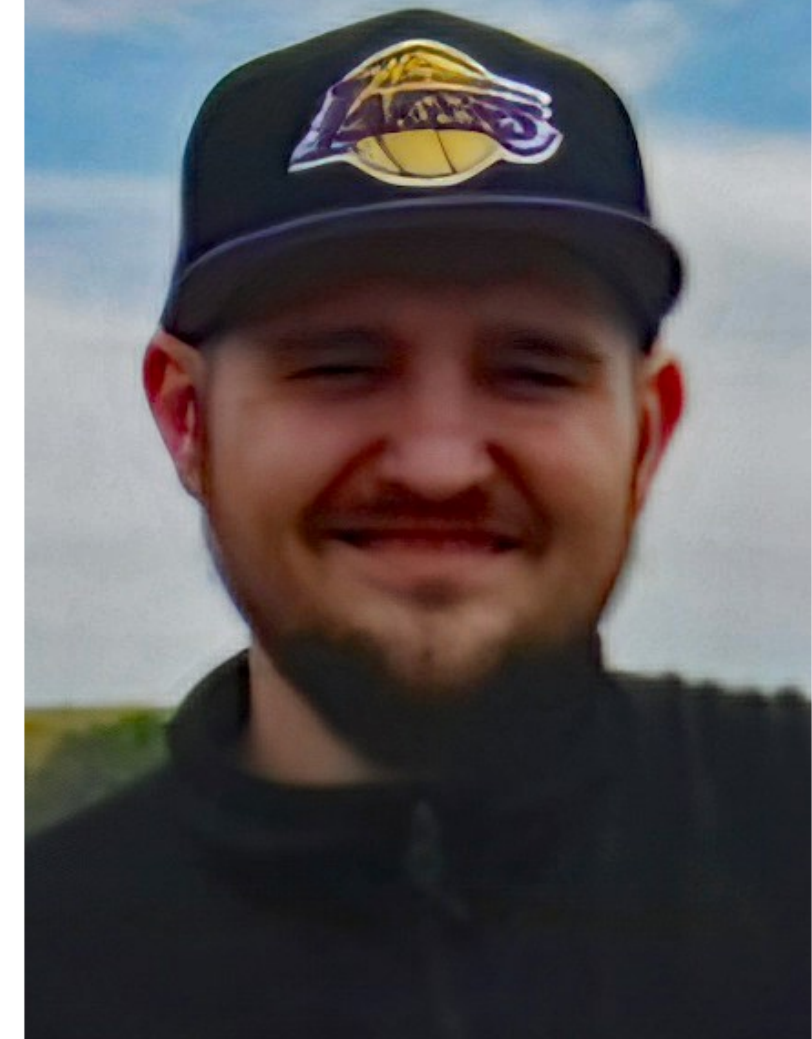

Cameron was born on April 18, 1997, in Kennewick, Washington to Gregg Schuetze & Linda Kueneman. Big brother, David Kueneman (11 years) and big sister Christina Richter (6 years) were so happy to welcome Cameron! In 1999, Linda and the kids moved to Glendale, Arizona. In 2000, Michael Thomas married Linda and became stepdad to David, Christina and Cameron. Cameron met his childhood best friend, Santiago Pedrego in their neighborhood and they had many adventures together. Santiago's mom was an extra mom to Cameron. Cameron attended school in Glendale, Arizona.

Cameron always admired and looked up to his big brother, David. Whatever sports team David liked, was Cameron's team too. It wasn't until Cameron was an adult that he decided he liked the Arizona Cardinals better than the New England Patriots. Cameron loved his big sister Christina. Cameron and Christina could push each other's buttons, but they made up and had fun together. Thanksgiving 2007 Cameron and his siblings spent with Daddy Gregg in Kennewick, Washington. David, Christina and Cameron were all in the wedding party welcoming Melody as
