That will never go away

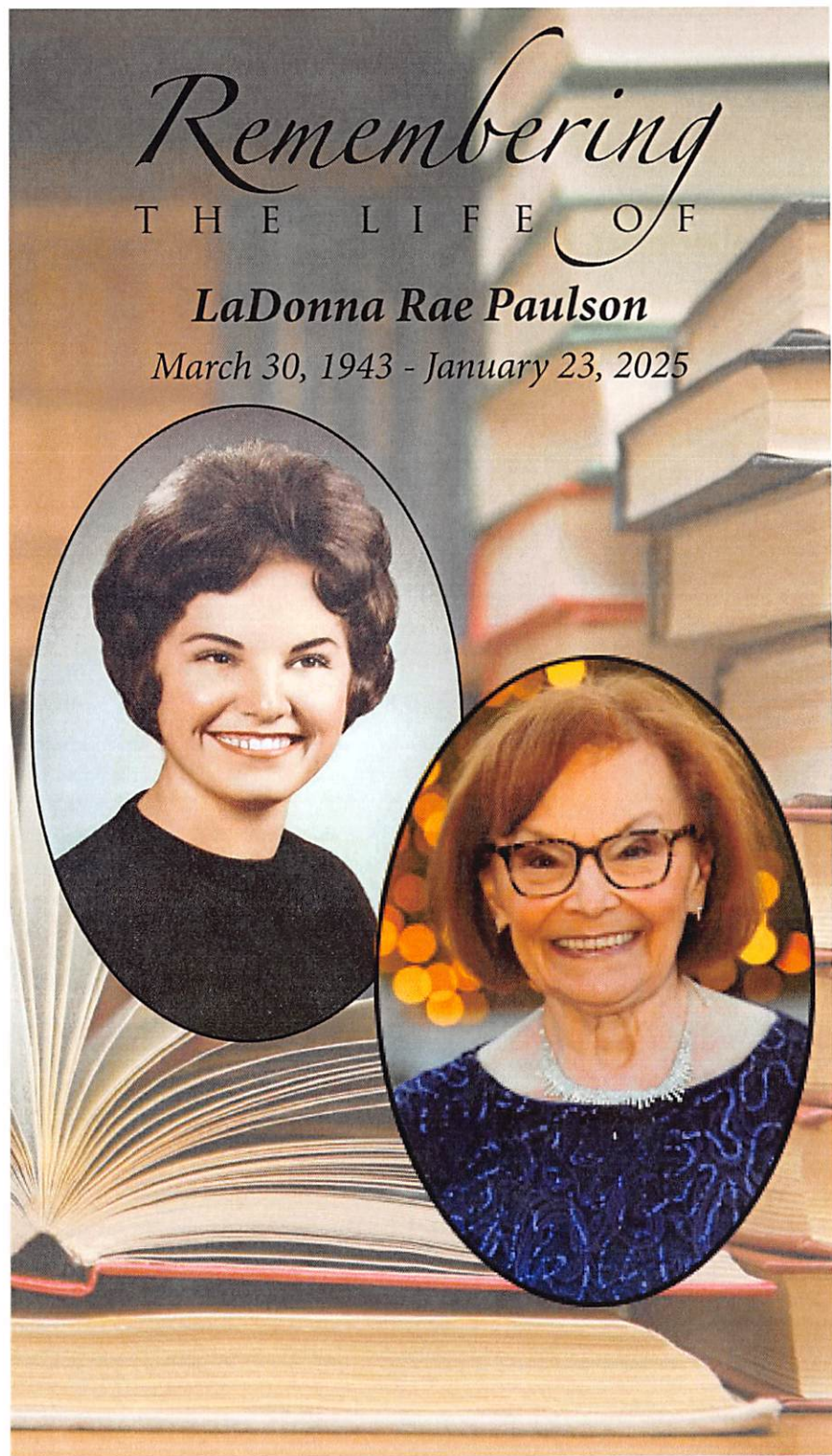
